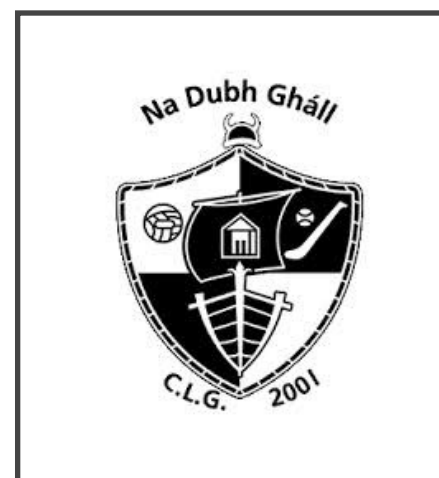

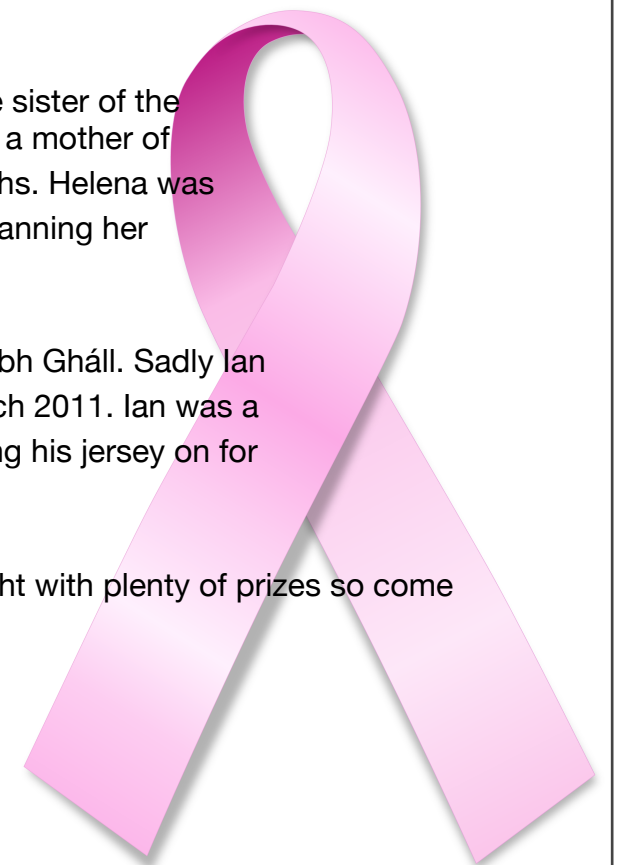
There will be a DJ, live band, food and a raffle on the night with plenty of prizes so come along and support the Skelly family.
